This warranty is only valid when PABCO® Roofing Products shingles are purchased and applied in the United States or Canada. This warranty specifically warrants that PABCO Roofing Products shingles are free from manufacturing defects that adversely affect their performance. The warranty provisions and limitations described herein are shown in the attached Reference Tables.

• LIMITED LIFETIME WARRANTY:

For designated products, the Limited Lifetime Warranty is offered to the original homeowner* on single family residential structures only. Single family residential structures do not include commercial structures of any kind, including, but not limited to, apartments, townhomes, condominiums, or other structures where multiple dwelling units are covered by a common roof. The Limited Lifetime Warranty is non-prorated per Table 1. After 480 months, the residual value remains at 20% of the original shingle purchase price.

For the purpose of this warranty, the original homeowner is defined as the purchaser of PABCO Roofing Products shingles at the time of installation for the purpose of roof repairs or replacements on existing homes, or the first occupier of the dwelling for the purpose of new construction.

• TRANSFERABILITY:

Upon transfer of ownership, the Limited Lifetime Warranty coverage ceases and reverts to a fully transferable, prorated 30, 40, or 50-year warranty period (see Reference Table 1 for details). See "Prorated Coverage" (as described below) for details.

• WARRANTY FOR ALL OTHER STRUCTURES:

The Limited Lifetime Warranty is only applicable to single family residential structures. The warranty lengths for all other structures are 30, 40 and 50 years, as shown in Reference Table 2 (excluding the special limited coverage, detailed below in Reference Tables 1 and 2). These structures include, but are not limited to, non-residential structures of any kind, apartments, town homes, condominiums, or other structures where multiple dwelling units are covered by a common roof.

• WARRANTY LIMITS:

Excluding "Unvented Roof Deck", the warranty term for PABCO Roofing Products shingles varies from 30 years to a Limited Lifetime depending on the type of shingle purchased (see Reference Tables). PABCO Roofing Products' warranty obligation to the owner ends when:

1. The shingles reach the end of their warranted life as set forth in Reference Tables 1 and 2.
2. The then-current owner re-roofs with another product.
3. A claim settlement has been reached, which includes and requires a release of all future liabilities.

• VENTILATION REQUIREMENTS:

To prevent harmful condensation, air must circulate freely under the roof deck with air flow in all areas. A minimum of 1 ft² of total net free ventilating area is required for each 150 ft² of ceiling area. 1 ft² for each 300 ft² of ceiling area may be allowed if at least 40% and not more than 50% of the required ventilating area is provided by attic exhaust vents located in the uppermost portion of the attic or rafter spaces. Roof systems that are not in compliance with this ventilation requirement are considered an "Unvented Roof Deck". For these roof systems, the warranty protection is limited to 10 years of prorated coverage for replacement of shingles which exhibit a manufacturing defect that adversely affects their performance.

• NON-PRORATED COVERAGE:

The period for non-prorated protection against manufacturing defects that adversely affect shingle performance can run up to 20 years, depending on the product and application. See Reference Tables 1 and 2 (and "Ventilation Requirements" above) for product specific details.

This non-prorated protection period includes replacement product (if available) and reasonable installation costs to repair or replace as PABCO Roofing Products determines, after a formal claim has been processed and accepted. Reasonable tear-off and disposal costs may be covered for certain products (see Reference Tables for details).

PABCO Roofing Products reserves the right to substitute product of similar quality and color if original product is not available. Items not covered under this limited warranty include metal work, flashing, or other related work. After the non-prorated warranty coverage expires, PABCO Roofing Products will base the settlement on the number of months of use that the shingles have performed through the date of the filing of the claim and reduce the amount of payment proportionally for the balance of the warranty. The Prorated Coverage information follows.

• PRORATED COVERAGE:

After the non-prorated period ends, protection during the balance of the warranty against manufacturing defects that adversely affect shingle performance is known as “Prorated Coverage”. It is limited to the reasonable cost of replacement shingles (reduced by the months of use). PABCO Roofing Products, at their sole discretion, reserves the right to provide replacement shingles as an alternative to paying the cost to repair or replace defective shingles.

• ALGAE DEFENDER®:

PABCO Roofing Products manufactures and makes available (on a regional basis) different types of algae resistant shingles featuring Algae Defender®. Shingles designated and sold as Algae Defender® are warranted to be free from obvious and unsightly black streaks caused by blue-green algae (cyanobacteria) for the “Algae Resistance Warranty” coverage period indicated in the Reference Tables.

If Algae Defender® shingles develop obvious and unsightly black streaks caused by blue-green algae (cyanobacteria) within the first 20 years after application, at its discretion, PABCO Roofing Products will repair, replace, or clean the affected shingles.

This coverage is limited to obvious and unsightly black streaks caused by blue-green algae (cyanobacteria) and does not apply to green algae, moss, mold, or any other staining determined not to be blue-green algae (cyanobacteria). To qualify for the Algae Defender® warranty, both the shingles and the hip and ridge must feature Algae Defender®.

• WIND WARRANTY PROTECTION:

Reference Tables 1 and 2 detail the maximum wind velocity and length of coverage for the Wind Warranty protection for each shingle product. The high wind warranty is available for new construction or re-roof with complete tear-off. Eligible shingles must be properly installed with six (6) nails as per application instructions, PABCO Roofing Products Universal Starter at the rakes and eaves, and Paramount® Starter at the eaves (when required). See the Application Instructions for the product being installed for additional details. This Wind Warranty protection does not apply to shingles which have not yet had the time and temperature exposure needed for Thermal Sealing (as defined below).

Thermal Sealing of Self-Sealing Shingles Defined: PABCO Roofing Products shingles contain self-sealing asphalt strips that must be subjected to direct warm sunlight to reach a temperature that activates the sealant strip before thermal sealing will occur. When shingles are installed during cool weather conditions, they may not seal until the temperature is high enough and lasts long enough to develop sealing conditions. Shingles applied in winter months which do not receive direct sunlight may not reach adequate surface temperatures and may not seal. This is the nature of self-sealing shingles and failure to seal under these conditions is not a manufacturing defect.

• WHAT IS NOT COVERED:

PABCO Roofing Products is not liable under this limited shingle warranty due to any roof failure other than those caused by manufacturing defects in the shingles. PABCO Roofing Products is not responsible for application, performance, or the consequences of failures of the full roof system unless the failure is resulting from a manufacturing defect in the shingles that adversely affects their performance. While this warranty describes certain benefits available to the owner, it is not an assurance that the shingles will remain serviceable for the length of the entire warranty period. In addition, after the shingles leave the manufacturing facility, they may be subjected to conditions and handling that affects their performance which is beyond PABCO Roofing Products’ control. This warranty does not cover conditions that may affect product performance but are not related to manufacturing defects, including but not limited to the following:

1. Violent, unusual weather conditions or acts of God such as, but not limited to, hailstorms, lightning, or winds greater than the wind limits stated for each shingle product in Reference Tables 1 and 2.

2. Shingles applied and exposed to normal wind areas without the recommended number of nails in the proper location on the shingle:

- fewer than four (4) nails in the proper location for Premier, Prestige and Tahoma
- fewer than five (5) nails in the proper location for Cascade™, Paramount and Paramount Advantage®
- fewer than six (6) nails in the proper location in areas where local knowledge indicates exposure to high winds is likely

In areas where local knowledge indicates high-wind exposure is likely, a minimum of six (6) nails must be in the proper location on the shingle as per the product packaging.

3. Damage or long-term consequences to the shingle roof system resulting from or caused by structural changes, alterations, additions, settlement, distortion, failure, or cracking of roof deck, walls, or foundation of the building or caused by the installation of equipment such as signs, air-conditioning equipment, or solar photovoltaic devices installed on or above the shingle roof system.

4. Damage to the shingles caused by residential or commercial grade cleaners, sealants, treatments, or solvents.

5. Defects in, or failure of, or damage caused by materials used as a roofing base over which the shingles are applied.

6. Damage caused by foot traffic of any kind, resulting in such damage as scuffing, cracking, or granule loss.

7. Shingles installed on “Geodesic Dome” construction are not warranted nor approved under any circumstances.

8. Appearance-related issues where there is no failure of the performance of the shingles including, but not limited to, surface cracks, fissures, granule loss, or coloration.

9. Damage to the sealant strip caused by dust, sand, or foreign matter preventing the sealant strip from activating and sealing the roofing shingles.

Damage to or failure of the roof system resulting from failure to follow the maintenance practices detailed in the PABCO Roofing Products technical bulletin Recommended Maintenance Practices. PABCO Roofing Products reserves the right to discontinue or modify any of its shingle products, including the color of the shingles, without notice to the present owner and shall not be liable for any such discontinuance or modification.

• DISCLAIMER OF WARRANTIES:

PABCO ROOFING PRODUCTS WARRANTS THAT ON THE DATE THE SHINGLES ARE MANUFACTURED AND FOR SHINGLES APPLIED ON OR AFTER MAY 1, 2023, THEY WILL MEET PABCO ROOFING PRODUCTS' STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS FOR THE RESPECTIVE SHINGLE AND WILL BE FREE FROM DEFECTS IN MATERIAL AND MANUFACTURE SUBJECT TO THE LIMITATIONS AND EXCLUSIONS DESCRIBED WITHIN THIS LIMITED SHINGLE WARRANTY DOCUMENT. THE WARRANTY CONTAINED IN THE PRECEDING SENTENCE IS THE EXCLUSIVE WARRANTY GIVEN BY PABCO ROOFING PRODUCTS AND SUPERSEDES ANY PRIOR, CONTRARY OR ADDITIONAL REPRESENTATIONS, WHETHER ORAL OR WRITTEN. IN ADDITION, THIS LIMITED WARRANTY REPLACES AND SUPERCEDES ALL PRIOR WARRANTIES. PABCO ROOFING PRODUCTS HEREBY DISCLAIMS AND EXCLUDES ALL OTHER WARRANTIES – WHETHER EXPRESS, IMPLIED OR STATUTORY – INCLUDING ANY WARRANTY OF MERCHANTABILITY, ANY WARRANTY OF FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE, AND ANY IMPLIED WARRANTIES OTHERWISE ARISING FROM COURSE OF DEALING OR USAGE OF TRADE.

• LIMITATION ON LIABILITY:

IN NO EVENT SHALL PABCO ROOFING PRODUCTS BE LIABLE FOR CONSEQUENTIAL, INCIDENTAL, SPECIAL, OR PUNITIVE DAMAGES OF ANY KIND, INCLUDING ANY DAMAGE TO THE BUILDING, ITS CONTENTS, OR ANY PERSONS THEREIN.

• THE CLAIM PROCESS:

To initiate a claim against this warranty, PABCO Roofing Products must be notified within 30 days of discovery of an alleged manufacturing defect, prior to roof repairs or replacement, or the expiration of the warranty. The claimant may initiate a claim at www.pabcoroofing.com/warranty/claims or call PABCO ROOFING PRODUCTS at 800-426-9762 or 253-272-0374 to request a claim packet.

When a claim packet is submitted, the homeowner's section must be filled out completely, signed, and dated. The claimant must provide proof of purchase, three (3) full shingles that clearly demonstrate the alleged defect and provide photos which show the scope of the complaint. All required claim information is the responsibility of the claimant and is to be forwarded to the address above at the cost of the claimant before the warranty has expired as described above in "Warranty Limits". All photos, samples, and/or documents provided become the property of PABCO Roofing Products and may not be returned.

Once the claim package is received, the complaint will be analyzed per the terms and limitations described in this warranty, and PABCO Roofing Products will endeavor to formally respond to the claimant within forty-five (45) days.

• WARRANTY REGISTRATION:
